Event for Model UN

Committees

(GA 1, ECOSOC, etc.)

Secretary General

Person responsible for entire conference.

Secretariat

Team organizing the conference.

Formal Debate

Speakers' List & Moderated Caucuses.

Informal Debate

Unmoderated Caucuses and Writing.

Resolution Drafting and Acclamation

Passing by majority or acclamation.

Delegation Composition

All delegates equal with a maximum of two people representing each delegation in each committee

Type of Delegation

Only countries and international organizations.

Background Guide

Information you receive regarding the debate at the conference.

Flow of Debate

Interchanging moderated and unmoderated caucuses; Delegations stay together.

Summit

Event for Model G20.

Meetings

(Finance Track, Sherpa Track, Leaders')

Leader of the G20 Presidency

Head of State representing the G20 Presidency (Germany since Dec. 1st, 2016).

G20 Presidency Team

Team organizing and overseeing the summit.

Working Sessions

Sherpa meetings, Finance meetings, and Leaders' meetings (including working lunch and dinner)

Drafting Sessions

Negotiations on language of Leaders' communiqué & action plan.

Communiqué and Action Plan Adoption

Passing by consensus rule.

Delegation Composition

Up to four people representing the delegation at each meeting. Roles within the delegation: Leader, Sherpa, Sous Sherpa, Finance Minister, Central Bank Governor, Senior Advisors

Types of Delegation

Countries, International Organizations, Outreach Groups.

Policy Notes

Information you receive regarding the German Presidency's agenda and the topics that will be debated at the summit.

Flow of Summit

Combination of simultaneous meetings and structured gatherings.
